DAY 1: EL PASO ARRIVAL AND OVER TO TRUTH OR CONSEQUENCES

Fly into El Paso, Texas. Upon arrival, pick up your car and make your way over to New Mexico in the natural springs town of Truth or Consequences.

DAYS 6-8: ZAPATA RANCH

Your next three days will be spent at Zapata Ranch, a working ranch near Great Sand Dunes National Park in Colorado. The ranch offers an extensive program for guests to experience life on a working cattle ranch while enjoying high-end amenities and gourmet food. Guests are hosted in one of the comfortable lodge rooms at the historic Zapata ranch headquarters. Wake up to a hot breakfast served in the rustic dining room before heading out for a morning horseback ride.

Horseback activities can include working and moving cattle, exploring the surrounding San Luis Valley, venturing into the adjacent Great Sand Dunes National Park, or participating in a specially-organized overnight pack trip into the Sangre de Cristo Mountains. “On-the-ground” activities include interpretive nature hikes, fly-fishing local streams, birding, wildlife watching, geology tours, and more.

Guests who desire a true working ranch experience are welcome to work alongside wranglers and ranch staff on various ranch projects. Or for those seeking maximum relaxation, massages and yoga sessions are available throughout their stay. Along the way, guests learn about how the ranches operate, land and cattle management philosophy, and the natural surroundings that make this valley so spectacular. And each night, the day’s activities are topped off by a gourmet dinner in back in the cozy dining room.

Overnight at Zapata Ranch

DAYS 9-10: COLORADO SPRINGS

Drive north to Colorado Springs and head up to the summit of Cheyenne Mountain, almost 3 kilometers in elevation, where you will be staying in a luxury cabin ranch with astounding views.

Spend the next day exploring the Pike National Forest on numerous hiking trails or with guided nature walks.

Overnight at The Broadmoor Cloud Camp

In the morning, make your way to Denver International Airport in time for your flight home.
